

Malaga Drilling School Joining Instructions

Getting to your hotel from Malaga Airport

You can find a taxi immediately outside the arrival terminal door. There is a constant stream of taxis so there is no need to book or wait. The average fare to Torremolinos is 20-23€ and the ride normally takes 15 minutes. On weekends, festive days and at night between 10:00pm and 06:00am the fare will be around 27-30€.

Trains are available from the airport every 20 minutes going to Fuengirola and stopping in Torremolinos.

From your hotel to Malaga Drilling School

If you are staying in a hotel that is within walking distance of Malaga Drilling School simply walk towards the square Plaza Andalucía. Ask at reception before you leave the hotel and they will point you in the right direction. Once you are on Plaza Andalucía look towards the Entreplazas building (where the green Mercadona supermarket sign is) and you will find us towards the right hand side of that same building.

If you are on the square Plaza Costa del Sol, walk through the building where the restaurant Comodoro is (under the large green Mercadona sign) and we are situated on the other side of the same building to the left (follow the signs once inside the building).

If you are unsure as to how you should proceed from your hotel please call Malaga Drilling School (0034 952 409 860). Give us the name of the hotel and we will inform you on how to get to the school.

What time should I arrive?

Please report to reception before 08:45am on the first morning. The rest of the week classes start at 09:00am.

What time do we finish on the last day?

The 3 day course should be finished on the last day (Wednesday) by 6pm. There is a taxi rank close to the school and it takes approximately 15 minutes to Malaga airport. Please note that passengers are required to be at the airport 2 hours prior to departure.

What should I bring with me?

You must bring your passport. You will also need a calculator.

You will be provided with all the necessary didactic materials including a hard copy of the manual as well as an electronic copy on a pendrive.
